

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Procedure and Results

Procedure: The stain solution was applied to a clean dry tile and allowed to remain on the tile for a period of 4 hours. After 4 hours the tile was scrubbed with tap water and a nylon brush and wiped dry. The tile was then allowed to air dry for a period of 24 hours.

***Note:** The Sealed sample was subjected to additional cleaning with 8 parts water and 1 part Clorox bleach. This mixture completely cleaned the tile surface changing the L rating (Light Stain) to an O rating (No Stain).

***Note:** The Sealed sample was subjected to additional cleaning with 8 parts water and 1 part Clorox bleach. This mixture cleaned the tile surface changing the L rating (Light Stain) to an O rating (No Stain) and changed the M rating (Medium Stain) to an L rating (Light Stain).
