#### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

Apply to the skin in generous amounts over all of the exposed areas 20 minutes before sun exposure, it should be reapplied every two hours or more often when sweating, and should be reapplied after swimming or toweling.

NOT TO BE USED FOR ANY OTHER PURPOSE, OR IN ANY MANNER, CONTRARY TO THIS LABEL UNLESS AUTHORISED.

#### **SAFETY PRECAUTIONS**

For external use only. If swallowed, seek medical advice. Do not apply to eyes, mouth or broken skin. Avoid contact with food and food utensils, with spectacle frames, soft plastics or synthetic fibres, timber fittings and furniture. Avoid prolonged exposure to the sun. Wear protective clothing, hats and eye-wear when exposed to the sun. Limit use if pregnant. For sensitive skins, test product for any skin irritation on a small area of skin first. If skin irritation and rash develops, discontinue use and seek medical advice.

#### STORAGE & DISPOSAL

KEEP OUT OF REACH FROM CHILDREN. Keep in an upright position, in a cool dry place. Store below 30°C in closed original container. Dispose of bottle by putting in garbage.

## WHEN USING SUNSCREEN REMEMBER:

- + No sunscreen provides full protection so never rely on sunscreen alone for sun protection.
- During the daily sun protection times (when the UV Index is 3 and above), combine sunscreen with sun-protective clothing, a broad-brimmed hat that protects the face, head, neck and ears, shade and sunglasses.
- Apply sunscreen 20 minutes before you go outside and again every two hours (whether or not the label tells you to do this).
- + Use a generous amount of sunscreen. The average-sized adult should apply more than half a teaspoon of sunscreen (about 3 ml) to each arm and the face/neck (including ears), and just over one teaspoon (6 ml) to each leg, the front of the body and the back of the body. That is, approximately 35 ml of sunscreen for one full body application.
- + Check and follow the 'use by' date stated on the packaging and store sunscreen below 30°C.
- If you have an allergic reaction to a sunscreen, try another brand. A doctor or chemist could also offer advice about choosing another product.
